MedWaves develops its activity under the Mediterranean Action Plan (MAP) for the protection and development of the Mediterranean basin, an organisation belonging to the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), acting as one of its Regional Centre.



Based on the decision of the Parties of the Convention for the Protection of the Mediterranean Sea against Pollution (Barcelona Convention), MedWaves was established in 1996 by means of a collaboration agreement between the Spanish Ministry of Environment and the Government of Catalonia. MedWaves is based in Barcelona and legally hosted by the Catalan Waste Agency.



MedWaves has been also designated as Regional Centre by the Parties of the Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs).

Why Promoting Sustainable Business Development?

Take-make-waste production and consumption models have led us to an unprecedented environmental crisis:


- Climate change

- Resource consumption beyond the planet's regenerative capacity
- Unsustainability coupled with rising social inequalities

→ Urgent shift towards sustainability is needed.

A sustainable business provides commercial solutions which create ecological value and/or safeguard the environment (addressing environmental challenges and/or reducing environmental impacts) and are economically viable and socially empowering.



Methodological Framework for Open Innovation Enablers





